INVITED FEDERATIONS	The Pan American Gymnastics Union invites all Federations affiliated to the PAGU and which are up to date in their obligations.
JUDGES AND JURIES	<ul> <li>Judges per Club and/or Federation:</li> <li>Federations with 1 to 3 units and with FIG brevet judges are required to provide at least one judge from categories 1, 2, 3, or 4.</li> <li>Federations with 4 or more units and FIG brevet judges must submit</li> </ul>



	<ul> <li>two judges from categories 1 to 4.</li> <li>For federations with category 3 or higher judges, one of the judges must hold the highest available category, while the second may be from category 4.</li> <li>If the country lacks FIG judges, clubs must supply certified judges with National, Regional or State brevet credentials.</li> <li>Club delegations with fewer than 10 athletes may partner with another small delegation to split the cost of providing a judge.</li> <li>Judges assigned to officiate at the Pan American Championship are also permitted to judge for a club during the Club Cup.</li> <li>A fine of USD \$1,000.00 per missing judge will be applied to federations that fail to meet the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC no later than October 13, 2025.</li> <li>The National Federation must inform PAGU of the of the judges it intends to nominate for the event by the time of the definitive registration deadline (September 12, 2025). This is necessary to allow for the timely appointment of invited neutral judges, if required.</li> </ul>

SAFEGUARDING	From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable. The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site. In addition, posters of the "10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics", the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm- up halls and public zones.
VISAS	Please verify immediately with your travel agency or the nearest U.S. Embassy or Consulate in your country whether a visa is required for travel to <b>Puerto</b> <b>Rico, a U.S. territory</b> . This is an urgent matter, as visa appointments and processing can take several weeks or longer. Early action is strongly recommended to avoid travel delays. The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) is available to assist each Delegation member by providing an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before October 13, 2025. To request the invitation letter, Delegation Members must send an email to acropanam2025pur@gmail.com. The LOC will then respond with the appropriate forms that must be completed in order to receive the official invitation letter. Alternatively, the form can be accessed through our official website. The form will request the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the PAGU will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The PAGU Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their delegation. The LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay. Please submit proof of insurance to the LOC by October 13, 2025, for the delegation. (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).
